We appreciate our craftsmanship heritage: the structural solutions have been tested for centuries in everyday use. Our furniture is designed to be used in contract environments, which means extra challenges for the structures. Our products can be safely used in public spaces.



## ENERGY

Our studio workshop uses hydropower as its 100% source of electricity: we have an old hydro power plant located next to our building.



## FREIGHTS

We collaborate with global freight forwarders that compensate harmful emissions and continuously search for better, improved ways to take care of the transportation - in harmony with nature.



## RAW MATERIAL

We use certified raw material from Northern Europe. We don't buy wood without knowing where and how it has been grown. All our products are carefully made in Finland.



## MINIMISING THE WASTE

Our goal is to minimise the amount of landfill waste in all our actions. In our design process we do our best to find clever solutions to use the raw material as effectively as possible. The waste wood is forwarded into small component manufacturing. Wood chips are used for growing shiitake mushrooms at a local farm. The waste from our office and kitchen is effectively recycled in the Finnish recycling system.



## BIODIVERSITY

We donate part of our sales profit to protect the biodiversity of the global forests. This way we want to help the small animals and plants - flora and fauna - where their natural habitat is threatened.
