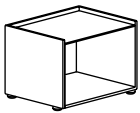

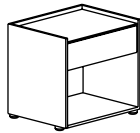
Bera is a collection of bedside tables, dressers and chiffoniers for the bedroom.

The top and drawers can be finished in a different colour or wood to the main body, allowing for endless combination possibilities.

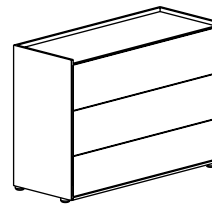

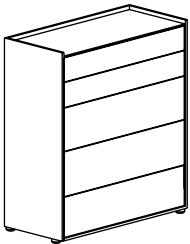

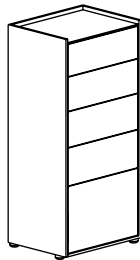

2. Materials

Structure and fronts:

Wood: Particleboard covered with natural wood veneer. Edges in wood veneer. Faces coated with UV cured acrylic and edges varnished with polyurethane.

Lacquer: MDF. Base coat UV varnish and finished with acrylic lacquer.

Hardware:

Hettich tracks and Blum hingespart with guides. Both parts on aluminum rails.

4. Product maintenance

For cleaning use a cloth moistened with water. Do not use solvents or cleaning products. Avoid placing penetrating liquids, essential oils, perfumes, on top of the furniture.

5. Packaging and transportation

All our products are duly packaged (cardboard, foams and Styrofoam). Our carriers are the most demanding for the characteristics of our products.

6. Assembly instructions

All our products include assembly instructions for their correct installation.
